A Louisiana native, he received his BS in biological sciences from LSU, his DDS and his prosthodontics postgraduate training from LSUHSC. He is the prosthodontics partner at Fusion Implant Center, an OMFS-Prosth dual specialty office providing same day, full-digital All-on X restorations under general anesthesia. Dr. Kiebach's main professional interest is in combining the best available technology with sound prosthodontics principles to improve patient outcomes in the most clinically efficient way possible. Dr. Kiebach has lectures both locally and nationally on digital workflows in full arch implant prosthodontics.</p> <p>TOPIC - <i>"Digital Workflows in Prosthodontics: from Complete Dentures to Full-Arch"</i></p> <p>In this presentation, Dr. Kiebach will give both an overview as well as a more in-depth discussion regarding his daily work as a Full-Arch implant prosthodontist.
